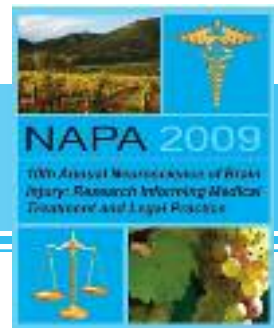

Our venue, the Silverado Resort, is spectacular and world-renowned. Register early to ensure room availability.

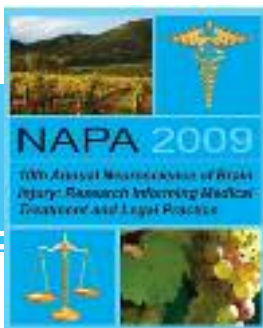

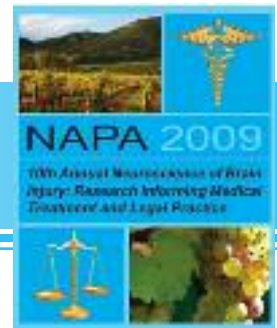

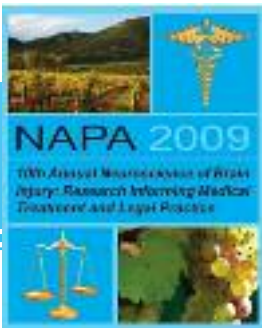

The above rates are non-commissionable, and are subject to the prevailing tax rate at the time of arrival. In addition, there is a \$20 per room, per night resort fee.

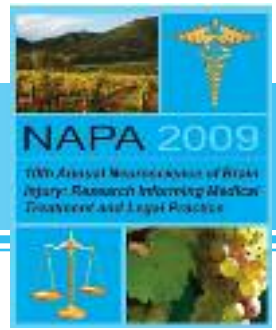

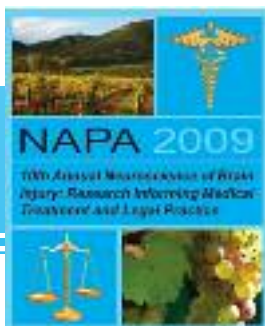
